


Man, or God made climate change?

The climate *is* changing


We have been warned that at the end of this age *the sun would scorch and burn* (solar flare or micro nova?). So, the climate *is changing* **but it is not man-made change**.

And this;

“Moreover **the light of the moon shall be as the light of the sun**, and the light of the sun shall be sevenfold, as the light of seven days, in the day that the LORD bindeth up the breach of his people, and healeth the stroke of their wound” (Isa 30.26).



The moon reflects 13.6% of sun light.⁴ If the sun radiated 7 times its normal light (a flare) this would scorch one side of the earth and the moon on the opposite side would give off $13.6 \times 7 = 95.2\%$ of the light of the sun. In other words, the moon would shine like the sun and the night would be turned into daylight on the other side of the planet. How did the ancients know that the sun would need to flare at 7 times (7.35%) its normal strength to make the moon shine like the sun?



And what about this;

“And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, *and* so great. And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath”. (Rev 16.18-19).

Is this huge earthquake literal? Well, the prophets indicate huge tectonic movement when Jesus returns. They say that the mount of Olives will split (Zech 14.4). That means the central rift valley will split open. The Great Rift Valley is a series of contiguous geographic trenches, approximately 6,000 kilometres in total length, that runs from the Beqaa Valley in Lebanon in Asia to Mozambique in south-eastern Africa. The rift cannot split open without other plates moving substantially.



Magnetic Motion

Magnetic pole shift⁶ is thought to cause catastrophic tectonic movements. It is linked with sun-spot activity (not necessarily causal) and with the way our whole galaxy is moving through the universe.




Again, why no ice age for 175 million years and why were all the continents joined in one great land mass (like a jig-saw puzzle)? We have no answers.⁷ There were glaciations before and after the dinosaurs. Some of the biggest global freeze events occurred long before animals appeared. It is believed that the sun was cooler in the past, making glaciation more likely. But carbon dioxide, which warms the Earth, was higher. The overall layout of the continents affects the degree to which glaciers can grow in the winter and shrink in the summer, and that has changed over time. The Earth's angle relative to the sun, and distance from the sun, vary over time in a complex fashion (Milankovitch cycles) and this also affects the growth of glaciers. But there are other important considerations that we do not fully understand. For example, the movement of the Earth through the Universe.

Apparently, “We know exactly how the Earth moves through the Universe, and it's both beautiful and simple.
